Radon Gas detected in Walnut Creek

We have had recent reports of some homes within our community testing positive for Radon Gas.

Radon is a cancer-causing, radioactive gas. It is colorless, odorless, and tasteless. When a person breathes radon, they increase their chances of getting lung cancer. In fact, the U.S. Surgeon General has warned that radon is the second leading cause of lung cancer in the U.S. today.

Radon comes from rocks, soil, and well water that contain uranium and radium.

Radon is found throughout the United States, and is particularly prevalent in Colorado. The U.S. EPA has ranked Colorado as a Zone 1 area, which means that the average house will probably exceed the EPA's action level for indoor radon.
